All ten have performances in the top 15 on the current TFRRS list. There are 22 individuals and 2 relay teams currently in qualifying position for the outdoor national championships.

Athletes can be nominated for consideration using the nomination form located on the Niagara Track & Field Hall of Fame website ([www.niagaratrackhof.org](http://www.niagaratrackhof.org)). Nominations can be made by any member of the general public including students, parents, coaches, competition officials, and athletic directors. Self-nominations are accepted.
